The programme will be organised under the guidelines of the Ministry of Human Resources "National Dual System Training" vocational courses.

The vocational courses are geared to prepare students with practical training and knowledge for the real world as technicians, supervisors, and entrepreneurs. The minimum qualification PMR entrant would take three years and six months to complete the full course in qualifying as a technician (18 months), supervisor (12 months) and entrepreneur (12 months). Those who have a flair for business may progress to the entrepreneurs levels so they may own or manage their own workshop or car dealership.
